

Troop 29 Can Recycling Instructions

About

Aluminum can recycling is one of the ways we raise money for our troop. Each scout is responsible for contributing to this effort by picking up aluminum pop cans, at the locations shown below, once or twice per year. 25% of the money collected will go into the scout's personal account, which can be used to pay for scout camps, fees, etc. The remainder goes into the troop account.

Process

1. Go to the church and hookup the pop can trailer
2. Get the location instructions and keys out of the tote in the trailer
3. Proceed to the locations and collect the cans
4. Sort out anything that is not aluminum right away
5. Take cans out of garbage bags or boxes and dump into the trailer
6. Keep trash separate
7. Take trailer full of cans to the recycling center (Mankato Iron & Metal or Alter Metal Recycling)
8. Check should be written out to Troop 29
9. Write your son's name on the check stub
10. Turn check into Jill Baston, Dan Baston or Carl Fitzloff.
11. Return pop can trailer to the church and discard trash
